

Nursery, Reception, Year 1 pupils back on site – Useful Information

Along with the Q & A document dated the 29th May, your form teachers will be sending out instructions to you directly. For pupils coming back on to site either Wednesday or Thursday. This document sets out additional details which may be useful to you.

Please ensure we have the correct emergency contact details for your family. If you are not sure whether these are up to date. Please email - Eleanor.skeen@tauntonschool.co.uk.

Children will need to have their equipment for the day with them. We would therefore ask you to apply sun cream before dropping your child at nursery/school. Could we also ask you to provide a labelled sun hat.

Upon arrival at school and at frequent intervals throughout the day, the children will be asked to either apply hand sanitizer or wash their hands thoroughly.

In order to control the risk of the spread of the virus on our school site, please could we remind you not to send your child to school if there is anyone in your home showing COVID-19 symptoms, or if anyone in the family has not been adhering to the current government guidance regarding social distancing. We all need to be doing what we can in order to minimize the risk to others in our community.

What to bring to school?

Labelled packed lunch box and any additional snacks in a sealed plastic box

Filled, labelled Water bottle

Pencil case (R, Y1)

Sunhat and any additional clothing required

Handcream – to be kept in your child's drawer, if needed.

ERIC book (R, Y1)

Pupils are not required to wear school uniform and should instead be in freshly laundered, practical home clothes each day.
