## Year 9 Syllabus in a nutshell – Fine Art

Year 9	Fine Art Activities
<b>Summer 2020</b>	There is no need for Year 9 students to consolidate this year's knowledge, understanding or skills in Art. Instead, we recommend that enthusiasts/students who plan to study Fine Art for GCSE challenge themselves by engaging with as many of the following activities as possible before returning in September:
<b>1</b>	Think of the theme of ' <b>JOURNEYS</b> ' and <b>produce a series of drawings, paintings or mixed media work</b> over the summer. Please think of the theme in the broadest possible way (e.g. past, present or future journeys from one destination to another; the role of maps, navigation and exploration; journeys through life; and journeys of the mind).
<b>2</b>	<b>Broaden your knowledge, understanding and skills by consulting the sources on the subject reading list</b> (e.g. read about artists, artworks and Art History in general; and use YouTube videos as inspiration for practical skill development, that is, try out some of the techniques at home).
<b>3</b>	Remember to add your name at the back of each piece of work and bring everything into school on the first day of the Autumn term (i.e. take your work to the Art Department so we can see what you have produced).
